Ken concluded 30 years of volunteer work in the field of golf administration in 1994 having served both the Alberta Golf Association and Royal Canadian Golf Association. His career started with the A.G.A. as a director but quickly evolved into being the business head of the association serving as its Secretary-Treasurer and housing the office of the organization in his home from 1971 to 1977.

The sport of golf boomed during his time as Secretary- Treasurer and the “A.G.A. business” became the “Sharratt family business” as Ken’s entire family was called on to do everything from mail outs to folding newsletters to stringing spectator entrance tags for the Alberta Open!



Ken also served as the A.G.A. President in 1980 before moving on to the Royal Canadian Golf Association Board in 1984 where he provided leadership for another 10 strong years.

Ken was appointed an Alberta Golf Association Honorary Lifetime Director in 1989 and presented a Royal Canadian Golf Association Distinguished Service Award in 2004.
