Course & Slope Rating

- A Course Rating is the expected score of a Scratch Golfer (0 Handicap) for this specific tee set
- A Slope Rating measures the relative difficulty of a course for Bogey Golfers compared to Scratch Golfers

These values combined with your Handicap Index help to determine your Course Handicap and Target Score

Stroke Indexes

Stroke Indexes are valued from 1 to 18 and are dispersed evenly through the holes. They consider relative difficulty for both Scratch and Bogey Golfers with lower values representing more difficult holes. Usage of these values impact:

- Allocation of strokes in Net Match Play
- Allocation of Points in Net Stableford
- Calculation of Net Double Bogey for your maximum score on a hole

High Single Hole Score

The maximum hole score allowed for handicap purposes is Net Double Bogey. This means it is limited to 2 strokes over par plus any strokes you might receive on the hole based on your Course Handicap and the Stroke Index of the hole

- The Score Centre app does this automatically when you enter your score hole by hole

Final 18 Hole Score

How your final score is used to adjust your Handicap Index:

- It turns into a Differential
 - (Adjusted Gross Score - Course Rating) X (113 / Slope Rating)
 - Based on the scorecard above as an example; (84 - 70.4) X (113 / 129) = 11.9
- Your best 8 of your last 20 differentials are averaged to calculate your Handicap Index
- The next time you play, your Handicap Index is converted to a Course Handicap based on the Course and Slope Rating of the tees and course you are playing.
- The Course Handicap helps determine:
 - Your Target Score for the round
 - How many strokes you receive for any Net calculations
